Name of Works: The Consulate General of India invites 'proposal for up-gradation of CCTV system with AMC including parts and labour for three years at India House located at 815 West Paces Ferry Road, Atlanta GA-30327.'

2. The Security Agencies/ Firms having good track record and relevant experience are eligible to apply. This tender document can also be downloaded from Consulate's website: <u>www.indiainatlanta.gov.in.</u>

3. The Tender shall be submitted in a Sealed Cover containing three sealed envelopes before 1700 hours on 16 March 2023 in the office of Head of Chancery, Consulate General of India. Any Tender received after this date and time will not be considered. Technical Bids shall be opened on 17th March 2023 at 1200 noon.

4. The Tender shall remain valid for a period of One hundred and eighty days (180) days from the date of opening or any extended period.

5. The value of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will be in the form of a cheque, Banker's cheque or Demand Draft. It shall remain valid for a period of Ninety (90) days with effect from the last date of submission stated above or any extended period. The EMD amount will be USD 500.00/-

6. The value of the **Performance Security** shall be Five Percent (5%) of the Contract Price.

7. Tenderer *I* Contractor shall quote his Lump-sum Fixed Price Amount based on the enclosed **Scope of work**. The Contractor shall note that quantities shall not form part of the agreement and he shall complete all the works as defined in the Scope of Work. The Contractor shall complete all the works as stated above irrespective of the quantities / details since these will not form part of the agreement, however the unit rates quoted there for items shall be used for working out the variations as per tender conditions.

8. Commencement of the works shall be effected 15 days from the date of issue of acceptance letter of intent or handing over the site, whichever is later.

9. The Period of Completion for the whole of the works is <u>120 days</u> calculated from the Fifteen days from the date of issue of acceptance letter of intent or handing over the Site, whichever is later. Such 15 days period being defined as the mobilization period. If the work is not completed within stipulated time liquidated damages will be levied.

10. The amount of Liquidated Damages payable by the Contractor to the Employer will be calculated @ 1% of accepted contract amount per week to be computed on per day basis limited to 10% of tender amount. Thetotal amount of liquidated damage shall be limited to 10% of Accepted Tender Cost.

11. The Defect liability period shall be Three Hundred Sixty Five (365) days.

12. The Consulate will not be bound to accept the lowest or any tender nor to give a reason for the rejection of any Tender.

13. The Tenderer must submit with his offer a list of Sub Contractors and Specialist names he proposes to use on the Works.

14. The Consulate, however, will always have the right to accept or reject any pre-approved subcontractor even after formal award of Contract and/or commencement of work with or without cause.

15. The successful Tenderer shall be responsible for coordinating his work with various Subcontractors and other bid-pack Contractors employed on the Works coordinating his work between various trades, obtaining all the necessary information from subcontractors for the purpose of the overall programming of his works; supplying all the normal attendance to all subcontractors and assuming the overall responsibility for the aforesaid.

- 1.1 Scope of work:
 - Supply & installation CCTV camera system at 815 West Paces Ferry Road, Atlanta, GA-30327.
 - Removal of old CCTV camera system.
 - Annual maintenance of the CCTV camera system for a period of three years.

1.2 All definitions set forth in the Conditions of Contract or in Other Tender Documents are applicable to the Tender offer.

The Tender comprises of:

- A) Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)
- **B)** Technical Bid:
 - Press Notice, Invitation to Bid, Instruction to Bid, Eligibility Criteria
- C) Financial Bid:
 - Form of Tender (Lump-sum price to be quoted on this form by Bidder)

 - Conditions of contract including standard formats for BG/ Guarantee etc.

1.3 The Consulate General of India will not be responsible to compensate for any expense or losses which may be incurred by the Tenderer in the preparation and submission of his Tender.

This is a LUMPSUM FIXED PRICE TENDER with Extent of work as defined in the Scope of Work enclosed. The Tenderer shall examine the Tender Documents and all Addenda (if any) before submitting his Tender and shall become fully informed as to the extent, quality, type and character of operations involved in the Works and shall visit and acquaint himself with the Site of the Works. No consideration or compensation will be given for any alleged misunderstanding of the articles to be furnished.

1.4 Tenderers are required to quote Lumpsum prices on "Form of Tender". Contractor shall satisfy himself about the quantities in Scope of Work in Tender Document. They are free to add/delete items, change quantities which are needed for completion of the job. These quantities shall not form part of the agreement, however, the unit rates quoted shall be used for variation if any.

1.5 All Tender documents (Appendix I-IX) must be returned properly filled in and completed in all respects in accordance with the conditions and Provisions of the Tender Documents. No alteration shall be made by Bidders to the Tender Document unless otherwise permitted.

1.6 The Lumpsum Fixed Price / amount and rates for variations must be quoted both in figures and words in US Dollars only. In case of any discrepancy between figures or words, the amount or rates quoted in words shall be taken to be correct for this tender.

1.7 The Lumpsum Fixed Price / amount shall be submitted according to the "Form of Tender", with suitable entries, including appropriate signatures, made in all blank spaces. The form shall not be altered. The Tenderer shall strictly comply with all the conditions stated in the Tender Documents. The Form of Tender must be signed by a person or persons authorized to sign the Tender and shall be dated. Evidence or signature

authority, such as a Power of Attorney, shall be provided with the Tender. The unit rates quoted in the tender documents shall be used towards variation as per the tender conditions. **Decision on bid will be taken based on the final price quoted on the Form of Tender.** Any mismatch in the final quoted price on Form of Tender and Total amount worked out on rates in the final price quoted on Form of Tender shall be considered for comparison of bids and decision on bid. The rates on schedule of quantity or elsewhere shall be adjusted in the ratio to match with quoted Final price on the form of tender.

1.8 Annual Maintenance Contract for three years

i. The bidders should attend the complaint within 24 hours of request.

ii. The bidder will provide all the parts and labour for AMC. No separate payment will be paid for any service regarding maintenance of CCTV system for three year for all locations.

iii. The amount of Liquidated Damages payable by the bidder for non attending the complaint within stipulated time for AMC will be calculated @ 0.1% of accepted contract amount per day. The total amount of liquidated damage shall be limited to 10% of Accepted Tender Cost except force majeure.

iv. Mission will only pay the charges of any additional work which is not covered under AMC. The AMC contract will be signed between L1 bidder and Consulate General of India's representative.

2. The Tenderer must submit with his Tender an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)of an amount of **US\$500.00** to Employer in the form of **Cheque. Banker's Cheque or Demand Draft** in favour **of Consulate General of India, Atlanta.** The EMD must be valid for 90 days. The EMD of unsuccessful bidder will be returned after the award of work while EMD of successful bidder can be adjusted against Retention Money at discretion of the Consulate.

3. Two bid system (Financial and Technical Bid)

3.1 The Tender shall be submitted in three sealed envelopes as described below:-

Envelope "C" Financial Bid Document

And addenda or other enclosures as required in the tender.

3.2 The three envelopes containing "A", "B" & "C" of offers shall be duly superscribed with above titles and "Description of work". The envelopes A, B and C to be put in another sealed envelope with the name of work written on top. The envelope "A" containing EMD shall be opened first and only those bidders who have fulfilled the requirements of the EMD will have the Technical part (Envelope B) of their bid opened and only those Bidders who have fulfilled the requirements of the requirements of the Technical information Envelope "B" shall have the Envelope "C" of their Bid opened. The decision of Consulate in this regard shall be final and binding on the tenders.

4. In case the tender is not decided during validity period of tender i.e. within 180 days from date of opening of tender. The Consulate may request to extend the bidder(s) to extend the validity of tender and Earnest money/tender security deposit for a further specified period beyond 180 days. Bidder(s) shall be at liberty to extend the validity of tender and Earnest money Deposit for the specified period or withdraw from tender. Once the validity is extended in writing by bidder(s), they will not be permitted to withdraw from

tender. If bidder(s) withdraws his offer in between, the Consulate shall be at liberty to forfeit the EMD absolutely

4.1 The acceptance of the Tender shall be conditional and not finally binding upon the Consulate until the actual contract signed between the Consulate and the Contractor. Should the Contractor fail to sign the contract within the stipulated time or for any other reason withdraw his participation in the Tender, the Consulate may withdraw his acceptance of the Tender without any notice or other formality and may enter into a new Agreement for the execution of the Works or any part of it and thereupon the amount of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall be confiscated by the Employer without any necessity for any legal or other formality or reference to judicial proceedings of proof of damage and without prejudice to the right of the Employer. No payment shall be released to the Contractor unless the agreement is signed.

5. 5.1 At any time prior to the date of opening of the proposals the Consulate may issue an addendum in writing toall persons or firms to whom the Tender documents have been issued, deleting, varying or extending any item of this acknowledged and so noted in the space provided in the Tender.

5.2 Unless it is in formal manner described above, any representation or explanation to the Bidder shall not be considered valid or binding on the Consulate as to the meaning of anything connected with the Tender Document.

5.3 The date and time for submission may be deferred by an official notification in writing issued by the Consulate General of India to all Bidders. Tenders received after this date will not be considered.

6. Force Majeure:- If, at any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war of hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God (hereinafter referred to as events) provided notice of happenings of such eventuality is given by either party to the other within 21 days from the date of concurrence thereof, neither party shall due to such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries under the contract shall be resume as soon as practicable after such an event come to an end or cease to exist, and the decision of the Purchaser as to whether the deliveries have beenresumed or not, shall be final and conclusive. Further, that if that performance in whole or part any obligation under this contract is prevented or construction

7. Settlement of Laws and Arbitration

All disputes, differences and questions arising out of or in any way touching or concerning this agreement or subject matter thereof or the representatives rights, duties or liability of the parties shall be conducted in accordance with and be subject to the UNCITRAL (United Nations Commission on international Trade Laws) Arbitration rules, as amended from time to time and the decision of the arbitrators as mentioned above shall be final binding on the parties.

The Arbitration will have its sittings at Consulate's jurisdiction.

- 8. Tender may be disqualified for any reason including, but not limited to the following:
 - If Tenderer sets forth any conditions which are unacceptable to the Employer.
 - If any tender is submitted under a name other than the name of the individual firm partnership or corporation that was issued the Tender Document.

- If there is evidence of collusion between Bidders.
- If Tenderer sets forth any offer to conditionally discount, reduce or modify its tender.
- If Bid price is disclosed before opening of Financial Bid.

9. The attention of Tenderer is drawn as to compliance with laws and regulations concerning safety and health, labour regulations, social insurance, labour taxes, tax deduction, import restrictions duties and levies, company's tax, input tax and output tax etc. All rates and sum inserted against items of works shall be exclusive of input Tax. Amount for output Tax shall be incorporated in Summary of Bid as specified therein.

10. If the bidder fails to quote separately for tax in the Main Summary of the bidding document as instructed, his bid price shall be deemed to be inclusive of tax and no adjustment will be made to his price in respect thereof.

11. The company selected for supply and installation of CCTV system will have to sign a non-Disclosure agreement prior to commissioning of the system.
